stitches used

Chain (ch)
Slip stitch (sl st)
Double crochet (dc)
Double crochet two together (dc2tog)
Treble (tr)
Half treble (htr)
Double treble (dtr)

approx 30cm

Princess Amelia

head and body

Using 3.75mm hook and Swing Pink make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnd 2: (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts

Rnd 3: (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 4: (3dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 5: (4dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 36 sts

Rnd 6: (5dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 42 sts

Rnds 7–12: 1dc in each st to end

Insert safety eyes between Rnds 9 and 10, spacing them ten sts apart

Rnd 13: (5dc, dc2tog) to end. 36 sts

Rnd 14: (4dc, dc2tog) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 15: (3dc, dc2tog) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 16: (2dc, dc2tog) to end. 18 sts

Stuff head

Rnd 17: (1dc, dc2tog) to end. 12 sts

Rnds 18–20: 1dc in each st to end

Rnds 21–22: rep Rnds 2–3. 24 sts

Rnds 23–24: 1dc in each st to end

Change to Charleston Pink

Rnds 25–33: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 34: rep Rnd 16. 18 sts

Stuff neck and body

Rnd 35: rep Rnd 17. 12 sts

Rnd 36: (dc2tog) to end. Six sts
Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and thread through rem sts, fasten off

neckband

Using 3.75mm hook and

Ballroom Blue make 21ch

Row 1: starting second ch from hook work one sl st in each ch to end. 20 sts

Fasten off

hair

Using 3.75mm hook and Deco White make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1–6: rep Rnds 1–6 of Head and Body. 42 sts

Rnds 7–11: 1dc in each st to end

Fasten off

tiara

Using 3.75mm hook and Sequin Purple make 20ch

Row 1: starting second ch from hook work 1dc in each st to end, turn. 19 sts

Change to Gatsby Green

Row 2: 1ch (does not count as st), three sl st, 1htr, 2tr in next st, 1htr, one sl st, 1htr, 2tr in next st, 3dtr in next st, 2tr in next st, 1htr, one sl st, 1htr, 2tr in next st, 1htr, three sl st

Fasten off

arm

Make two

Using 3.75mm hook and Swing Pink make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. Nine sts

Rnds 2–3: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 4: (1dc, dc2tog) to end. Six sts

Stuff hands, cont to lightly stuff as you work

Rnds 5–13: 1dc in each st to end

Change to Ballroom Blue

Rnds 14–15: 1dc in each st to end

Change to Charleston Pink

Rnd 16: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnd 17: rep Rnd 1. 18 sts

Rnds 18–20: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 21: rep Rnd 4. 12 sts

Rnd 22: (dc2tog) to end.

crochet clever

When attaching the overskirt and tiara to your princess, carefully pull the sequin strand away from the Sequin Purple yarn so that it doesn't snag

2tr, 2tr in next st, (3tr, 2tr in next st) to end, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch, turn. 30 sts

Rnd 4: 3ch, miss next st, 3tr, 2tr in next st, (4tr, 2tr in next st) to end, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch, turn. 36 sts

Rnds 5–9: 3ch, miss next st, 1tr in each st to end, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch, turn
Rnd 10: 3ch, miss next st, 1tr in each st to end, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch, turn

Change to Ballroom Blue
Rnd 11: (5dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 42 sts

Rnd 12: (6dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 48 sts

Rnd 13–14: 1dc in each st to end
Fasten off

waistband

Using 3.75mm hook and

Ballroom Blue pick up a loop from any st at back of top edge of Underskirt

Rnd 1: (1ch, 1dc) in same st, 1dc in each st to end. 24 sts

Rnd 2: 1dc in each st to end
Fasten off

overskirt

Using 3.75mm hook and Sequin Purple make 25ch
Row 1: starting second ch from hook work 1dc in each ch to end, turn. 24 sts

Note: 3ch at beg of each row counts as first tr

Row 2: 3ch, miss next st, 2tr, 2tr in next st, (3tr, 2tr in next st) to end, turn. 30 sts

Row 3: 3ch, miss next st, 3tr, 2tr in next st, (4tr, 2tr in next st) to end, turn. 36 sts

Row 4–9: 3ch, miss next st, 1tr in each st to end, turn

Row 10: 3ch, miss next st, 1tr in each st to end
Fasten off

to make up

Place Neckband around neck and sew ends centrally to top of bodice. Sew a small button where they join. Oversew tops of each Arm closed and sew underside of sleeve puffs to sides of Body just below neck. Sew each Leg to base of Body. Feed legs through top opening of Underskirt and slide skirt into place around middle of Body. Sew Underskirt to Body around base of Waistband. Pin Overskirt to base of

Waistband with opening at front and sew in place around top edge. Cut 30cm lengths of Deco White. Take two strands at a time, fold in half and pull a loop through st on edge of Hair. Feed ends through loop and pull tight to form tassel. Rep, using remainder of Deco White ball. Sew edge of Hair to top and back of head. Make centre parting and plait strands of Deco White on either side. Position each plait over rem hair and sew in ends at back of head. Sew a running st of Charleston Pink for mouth. Sew base of Tiara around front edge of Hair. Colour cheeks with pink crayon

Six sts
Fasten off

leg

Make two

Using 3.75mm hook and Charleston Pink make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnds 2–3: rep Rnds 2–3 of Head and Body. 24 sts

Rnd 4: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 5: 3dc, (dc2tog) to last three sts, 3dc. 15 sts

Rnd 6: 3dc, (dc2tog)

twice, 1dc, (dc2tog)

twice, 3dc. 11 sts

Rnds 7–10: 1dc in each st to end

Stuff feet, cont to stuff as you work

Change to Ballroom Blue

Rnds 11–30: 1dc in each st to end

Fasten off

underskirt

Using 3.75mm hook and Gatsby Green make 24ch, join with a sl st to form a ring

Rnd 1: 1dc in each st to end, turn. 24 sts

Note: 3ch at beg of each row counts as first tr

Rnd 2: 3ch, miss next st, 1tr in each st to end, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch, turn

Rnd 3: 3ch, miss next st,
