MONTGOMERY REINDEER

Make Rudolph's grandson to
spoil a little one with!

One of the best ways to get into the spirit of Christmas is being around children, whose enthusiasm for the big day is infectious! **IRENE STRANGE'S** Montgomery reindeer is a lovely gift for an excitable child and will be the perfect guiding light for your own amigurumi journey. With his smiley expression and big red nose, we're sure you'll agree he's the spitting image of his grandfather Rudolph.

Montgomery reindeer

HEAD AND BODY

Using 3.75mm hook and Velvet Cream make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnd 2: (2dc in next st, 1dc) to end. 18 sts

Rnd 3 and every odd-numbered rnd: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 4: (2dc in next st, 2dc) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 6: (2dc in next st, 3dc) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 8: (2dc in next st, 4dc) to end. 36 sts

Rnds 9-14: 1dc in each st to end
Change to Rich Purple

Rnds 15-24: 1dc in each st to end
Insert safety eyes

Rnd 25: (dc2tog, 4dc) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 26: (dc2tog, 3dc) to end. 24 sts

Safety first

If making Montgomery for a baby or small child, be sure to use safety eyes or embroider them with black yarn instead



Rnd 27: (dc2tog, 2dc) to end. 18 sts
Stuff

Rnd 28: (dc2tog, 1dc) to end. 12 sts

Rnd 29: (dc2tog) to end. Six sts
Fasten off

MUZZLE

Using 3.75mm hook and Velvet Cream make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1-2: rep Rnds 1-2 of Head and Body. 18 sts
Rnd 3: rep Rnd 4 of Head and Body. 24 sts

Rnds 4-6: 1dc in each st to end
Fasten off

NOSE

Using 3.75mm hook and Frosted Cranberry make a magic ring, work 5dc into ring. Five sts

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 10 sts

Rnd 2: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 3: (dc2tog) to end. Five sts
Fasten off

TAIL

Using 3.75mm hook and Velvet Cream make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnds 2-3: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 4: (dc2tog) to end. Six sts
Fasten off

FOOT

Make two
Using 3.75mm hook and Velvet Cream make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

* **Rnd 1:** 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnd 2: 1dc in each st to end
Change to Rich Purple

Rnds 3-7: 1dc in each st to end
Fasten off *

ARM

Make two
Using 3.75mm hook and Velvet Cream make a magic ring, work 5dc into ring. Five sts
Rep from * to * of Foot

EAR

Make two
Using 3.75mm hook and Velvet Cream make 7ch

Row 1: 1dc in second ch from hook, 1htr, 3tr, 3htr in next st, turn, work along opposite side of ch as folls: 3tr, 1htr, 1dc. 13 sts

Row 2: 1ch, 6dc,

3dc in next st, 1dc in each st to end. 15 sts
Fasten off

ANTLER

Make two
Using 3.75mm hook and Rich Purple make a magic ring, work 5dc into ring. Five sts
Rnds 1-4: 1dc in each st to end
Fasten off

ANTLER BRANCH

Make four (one on each side of each Antler)
Using 3.75mm

hook and Rich Purple join yarn to a st on Antler and make 4ch, starting second ch from hook work 1dc in each ch, join with a sl st to Antler
Fasten off

TO MAKE UP

Sew in all ends. Sew up opening of Body. Sew Muzzle to Body above Rich Purple section, stuffing before sewing on. Sew Nose to Muzzle. Stuff Tail. Sew to back of Body. Stuff Feet and Arms. Sew to front of

Body. Sew Ears and Antlers to head.

Embroider a nose

and smile onto Muzzle using Rich Purple

If you want to personalise your reindeer and give it a fun festive look, change the Rich Purple part of the body by instead working in a one-round stripe sequence of your choice
