## FRARKDRACHI-XXCIIUER

Note: when changing colour, join new colour during last dec of prev rnd

## Head

Using 4mm hook and Mellow Yellow make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring Six sts
Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts
Rnd 2: (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts
Rnds 3-7: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 8: (5dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 21 sts
Rnd 9: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 10: (6dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts
Rnds 11-13: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 14: (7dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 27 sts
Rnds 15-16: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 17: (8dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 30 sts Rnds 18-19: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 20: 12dc, (2dc in next st) six times,
1dc in each st to end. 36 sts
Change to Dancer Beige
Rnd 21: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 22: (5dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 42 sts
Rnd 23: (6dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 48 sts
Rnds 24-25: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 26: (6dc, dc2tog) to end. 42 sts Rnd 27: ( $5 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{dc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ) to end. 36 sts Rnd 28: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 29: (4dc, dc2tog) to end. 30 sts Rnd 30: 1dc in each st to end Rnd 31: (3dc, dc2tog) to end. 24 sts Rnd 32: 1dc in each st to end Remove hook from working loop and place working loop onto a locking st marker
Insert safety eye on each side of Rnd 20 increase
Stuff
Replace working loop back onto hook
Rnd 33: (2dc, dc2tog) to end. 18 sts
Rnd 34: (1dc, dc2tog) to end. 12 sts
Rnd 35: (dc2tog) to end, join with a sl st to first st. Six sts
Fasten off

## Body

Using 4mm hook and Gallop Blue make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts Rnds 1-2: rep Rnds 1-2 of Head. 18 sts Rnd 3: (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts Work in foll two-rnd stripe sequence: (Jumper Red, Dizzy Pink, Mellow Yellow, Wurlitzer Jade, Gallop Blue) six times, Jumper Red, Dizzy Pink, Mellow Yellow, Wurlitzer Jade

Rnd 4: (3dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 30 sts Rnd 5: (4dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 36 sts

## Rnd 6 and every even-numbered rnd:

1dc in each st to end
Rnd 7: (5dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 42 sts Rnd 9: (6dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 48 sts
Rnd 11: (7dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 54 sts
Rnds 12-14: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 15: 21dc, dc2tog, 8dc, dc2tog, 21dc. 52 sts
Rnd 16: 21dc, dc2tog, 6dc, dc2tog, 21 dc .50 sts
Rnd 17: 21dc, dc2tog, 4dc, dc2tog 21dc. 48 sts
Rnds 18-20: 1dc in each st to end Rnd 21: (10dc, dc2tog) to end. 44 sts
Rnd 22: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 23: (9dc, dc2tog) to end. 40 sts
Rnds 24-52: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 53: 4dc, dc2tog, 28dc, dc2tog, 4dc. 38 sts
Rnd 54: 3dc, dc2tog, 28dc, dc2tog,
3dc. 36 sts
Rnd 55: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 56: 2dc, dc2tog, 12dc, (2dc) in next st, 2dc, (2dc) in next st, 12dc, dc2tog, 2dc
Rnd 57: 1dc, dc2tog, 12dc, (2dc) in next st, 4 dc , (2dc) in next st, 12dc, dc2tog, 1dc
Rnds 58-66: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 67: (4dc, dc2tog) to end. 30 sts

## CROCHETCOOL

If you don't have a locking stitch marker in your stash, a small safety pin makes a suitable alternative because it uses the same closing mechanism. Tying a small length of yarn would work too, and Clover also stock a range of markers for this purpose!

Remove hook from working loop, place loop onto st marker, stuff Body, replace working loop back onto hook
Rnd 68: (3dc, dc2tog) to end. 24 sts
Rnd 69: (2dc, dc2tog) to end. 18 sts
Rnd 70: (1dc, dc2tog) to end. 12 sts
Rnd 71: (dc2tog) to end, join with a sl st to first st. Six sts
Stuff
Fasten off

## Tail

Using 4mm hook and Wurlitzer Jade make a magic ring, work 4dc into ring Four sts

Rnd 1: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 2: (2dc in next st, 1dc) to end. Six sts
Rnd 3: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 4: 2dc in next st, 1dc in each st to
end. Seven sts
Rnds 5-6: 1dc in each st to end Change to Gallop Blue
Rnd 7: rep Rnd 4. Eight sts
Rnd 8: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 9: rep Rnd 4. Nine sts
Rnds 10-12: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 13: 1dc in each st to end, join with a sl st to first st
Fasten off

## Ear

Make two
Using 4 mm hook and Mellow Yellow (Mellow Yellow) make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts
Rnds 1-3: rep Rnds 1-3 of Body. 24 sts
Rnds 4-5: 1dc in each st to end
Change to Dancer Beige (Dancer Beige)
Rnd 6: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 7: (10dc, dc2tog) to end. 22 sts
Rnd 8: (9dc, dc2tog) to end. 20 sts
Rnd 9: (8dc, dc2tog) to end. 18 sts
Rnd 10: (7dc, dc2tog) to end. 16 sts
Change to Jumper Red (Gallop Blue)
Rnds 11-12: 1dc in each st to end
Change to Dancer Beige (Dancer Beige)
Rnds 13-15: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 16: (6dc, dc2tog) to end. 14 sts

Rnd 17: 1dc in each st to end, join with a sl st to first st
Fasten off

## Foot

Make four
Using 4mm hook and Dancer Beige make 7ch

Rnd 1: 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in each of next four ch, 3dc in next ch, work back along opposite side of ch as folls: 1dc in each of next four ch, 2dc in same ch as first st. 14 sts

Rnds 2-4: 1dc in each st to end Change to Jumper Red (Mellow Yellow, Gallop Blue, Dizzy Pink
Rnds 5-6: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 7: (dc2tog, 5dc) to end. 12 sts
Rnd 8: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 9: 1dc in each st to end, join with a sl st to first st
Stuff lightly
Fasten off

## To make up

Sew Tail to bottom end of Body. Sew seams of Feet closed. Sew one Foot to each side of Body so two are at back and two at front. Sew one Ear to each side of Head. Cut a small triangle of black felt for nose, round off edges and sew in place as pictured. Sew Head to Body
