

No Christmas choir is complete without our **Singing frog**

Resplendent in his red and white hat, Gerald the frog loves to belt out all the festive classics. And his favourite Christmas meal? Mince flies of course! Make Irene Strange's frog with an open mouth by following our instructions, or for a closed mouth, make two top body pieces and omit the mouth, then sew the two halves together.



An instruction such as (3dc, 2dc in next st), as in Round 4 of the mouth, means you need to work one double crochet in each of the next three stitches, then two double crochets in the next stitch

stitches used

Chain (ch) Double crochet (dc) Double crochet two together (dc2tog)

SIZE Height excl. hat: 6.5cm

mouth

* Using 3.5mm hook and Festive Red make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts **Rnd 1:** 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts **Rnd 2:** (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts **Rnd 3:** (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts **Rnd 4:** (3dc, 2dc in next st) to end *, join with a sl st to first st. 30 sts Fasten off

top body half

Using Holly Green work as for Mouth from * to *. 30 sts **Rnd 5:** (4dc, 2dc in next st). 36 sts **Rnd 6:** (5dc, 2dc in next st). 42 sts **Rnds 7–8:** 1dc in each st to end

Place Mouth and Top Body Half tog so sts line up

Rnd 9: working through both pieces 18dc along edge, working through Top Body Half only 1dc in each st to end Fasten off

bottom body half

Using Pistachio Green work as for Mouth from * to *. 30 sts **Rnd 5:** rep Rnd 5 of Top Body Half. 36 sts Place Mouth and Bottom Body Half tog so sts line up

Rnd 6: working through both pieces 12dc along edge, working through Bottom Body Half only 1dc in each st to end Fasten off

eye Make two

Using 3.5mm hook and Holly Green make a magic ring, work 5dc into ring. Five sts Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. Ten sts Rnds 2–3: 1dc in each st to end Sacton off



leg

Make two Using 3.5mm hook and Holly Green make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring, Six sts Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to

end. 12 sts **Rnds 2–3:** 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 4: (dc2tog) to end. Six sts

Rnds 5–6: rep Rnds 2–3 Rnd 7: working in front loops only 2ch, (1htr, 2tr) in next st, 3tr in next st, (2tr, 1htr, 2ch, one sl st) in next st, 3dc. 12 sts

Rnd 8: starting in first htr from prev rnd 1dc, (1dc, 3ch, 1dc) in next st, 2dc, (1dc, 3ch, 1dc) in next st, 2dc, (1dc, 3ch, 1dc) in next st, 1dc, one sl st in next st Fasten off

hat

Using 3.5mm hook and Festive Red make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts Rnd 1: (2dc in next st, 2dc) to end. Eight sts Rnd 2: (2dc in next st, 3dc) to end. Ten sts Rnd 3: (2dc in next st, 4dc) to end. 12 sts Rnd 4: (2dc in next st, 5dc) to end 14 sts Rnd 5: (2dc in next st, 6dc) to end. 16 sts Rnd 6: 1dc in each st to end



Change to Shimmer White **Rnd 7:** rep Rnd 6 Fasten off

to make up

Sew Top and Bottom Body Halves tog, stuffing as you sew. Using Holly Green embroider around upper edge of Mouth to create top lip, building up two thicker layers towards middle. Embroider around bottom lip with Pistachio Green yarn, building up a thicker layer of yarn towards middle. Place a safety eye into each Eye piece and sew to top of body. Using Pistachio Green embroider three toes onto each Foot as shown. Sew Hat to top of Head. Make a small pom-pom from Shimmer White and sew to tip of Hat
