To make a bigger toy without changing the instructions just double up on your yarn and try a bigger hook

Stitches used:

Chain (ch)

Slip stitch (sl st)

Double crochet (dc)

Double crochet two together (dc2tog)

Double crochet three together (dc3tog)

Half treble (htr)

Double treble (dtr)

Treble (tr)

Patrick platypus body

Using 3.5mm hook and blue yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: 2dc into each st. 12 sts

Rnd 2: (1dc in first st, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts

Rnd 3: (1dc in first two sts, 2dc in next st).

24 sts

Rnd 4: (1dc in first three sts, 2dc in next st) to end. 30 sts

Rnds 5-19: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 20: working in front loops only (1dc in next three sts, dc2tog) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 21: working in both loops (1dc in next two sts, dc2tog) to end. 18 sts

Stuff

Rnd 22: (dc2tog) to end. Nine sts

Rnd 23: (dc3tog) to end. Three sts

Fasten off

nose

Using 3.5mm hook and yellow yarn make 7ch

Rnd 1: starting second ch from hook work 1dc in first five sts, 3dc in last st, work around other side of ch back to beg as folls: 1dc in each of next four sts, 2dc in next st, sl st to first st. 14 sts

Rnds 2-4: 1ch, 1dc in each st to end, sl st to first st

Fasten off, leaving long tail

tail

Using 3.5mm hook and yellow yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: (2dc in first st, 1dc in next two sts) to end. Eight sts

Rnd 2: (2dc in first st, 1dc in next three sts) to end. Ten sts

Rnd 3: (2dc in first st, 1dc in next four sts) to end. 12 sts

Rnd 4: (2dc in first st, 1dc in next five sts) to end. 14 sts

Rnd 5: (2dc in first st, 1dc in next six sts). 16 sts

Rnds 6-11: 1dc in each st to end

Fasten off, leaving long tail

paws

Make four

Using 3.5mm hook and yellow yarn make 4ch

Row 1: starting second ch from hook work 1dc in each st, turn. Three sts

Row 2: 1ch, 2dc in first st, 1dc in next two sts, turn. Four sts

Row 3: 1ch, 2dc in first st, 1dc in next three sts, turn. Five sts

Row 4: 1ch, 2dc in first st, 1dc in next four sts, turn. Six sts

Row 5: 1ch, 2dc in first st, 1dc in next five sts. Seven sts

Fasten off, leaving long tail

to make up

Sew up Body opening. Sew Nose to Body, level with Rnd 8 of Body. Sew Tail to Body, level with Rnd 20 of Body. Sew two Paws level with Rnd 20 of Body,

sew two Paws five rnds below Nose. Sew on two black beads for eyes

Perry piggybank body

Using 3.5mm hook and pink yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1-4: work as for Platypus Body. 30 sts

Rnd 5: (1dc in first four sts, 2dc in next st) to end. 36 sts

Rnds 6-8: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 9: (1dc in first four sts, dc2tog) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 10: (1dc in first three sts, dc2tog) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 11: (1dc in next two sts, dc2tog) to end. 18 sts

Rnd 12: (1dc in first st, dc2tog) to end. 12 sts

Rnd 13: (dc3tog) to end. Four sts
Fasten off

nose

Using 3.5mm hook and pink yarn make a magic

ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: (2dc in each st) to end. 12 sts

Rnd 2: (1dc in first three sts, 2dc in next st) to end. 15 sts

Rnd 3: working in back loops only (1dc in first three sts, dc2tog) to end. 12 sts

Rnd 4: working in both loops dc2tog to end, sl st to next st. Six sts
Fasten off

feet

Make four

Using 3.5mm hook and pink yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1-3: (1dc in each st) to end
Fasten off

ears

Make two

Using 3.5mm hook and pink yarn make 6ch

Row 1: starting second ch from hook 1dc in first st, 1htr in same st, 1tr in next st, 1dtr in next st, 1tr in next st, 1htr in next st, 1dc in same st. Seven sts
Fasten off



tail

Using 3.5mm hook and pink yarn make 9ch

Row 1: starting second ch from hook work one sl st in each st to end. Eight sts
Fasten off

lucky coin

Using 3.5mm hook and yellow yarn make 14ch

Row 1: starting second ch from hook, * 1dc in next st, 1htr in next st, 1tr in next two sts, 1htr in next st, 1dc in next st *, sl st in next st, rep from * to *
Fasten off

to make up

Sew up Body opening. Stuff Nose and Feet and sew to Body. Sew Ears to Body, above Nose. Sew Tail to Body. Fold Coin in half, sew up along edges, sew to top of Body. Sew on beads for eyes

Sunny seal body

Using 3.5mm hook and white yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1-8: work as for Piggybank Body. 36 sts

Rnd 9: (1dc in first ten sts, dc2tog) to end. 33 sts

Rnd 10: (1dc in first nine sts, dc2tog) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 11: (1dc in first eight sts, dc2tog) to end. 27 sts

Rnd 12: (1dc in first seven sts, dc2tog) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 13: (1dc in first six sts, dc2tog) to end. 21 sts

Rnd 14: (1dc in first five sts, dc2tog) to end. 18 sts

Rnds 15-20: dc2tog, 1dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnd 21-23: 1dc in each st to end
Fasten off
Divide rem sts in half, work tail (below) on each half as follows:

Rnd 1: 1dc in each st to end. Six sts

Rnd 2: 1dc in first two sts, 2dc in next two sts, 1dc in next two sts. Eight sts

Rnd 3: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 4: 1dc in first three sts, dc2tog, 1dc in next three sts. Seven sts

Rnd 5: 1dc in first two sts, dc2tog, 1dc in next three sts. Six sts

Rnd 6: 1dc in first two sts, dc2tog, 1dc in next two sts. Five sts

Rnd 7: 1dc in first st, dc2tog, 1dc in next two sts. Four sts

Rnd 8: (dc2tog) twice. Two sts
Fasten off

front flippers

Using 3.5mm hook and white yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts
Rnds 1-3: 2dc in first st, 1dc in each st to end.

Nine sts

Rnds 4-6: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 7: dc2tog, 1dc in each st to end. Eight sts

Rnd 8: dc2tog, 1dc in each st to end, sl st in first st. Seven sts
Fasten off

cheeks

Make two

Using 3.5mm hook and white yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1-2: 1dc in each st to end

Fasten off

to make up

Sew up tip of tail. Sew front flippers to Body. Stuff cheeks and sew to front of face. Sew on black beads for eyes. Embroider Nose and mouth with pink yarn. Apply small amount of blusher to sides of face

Oscar octopus

body & outer legs

Using 3.5mm hook and green yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1-4: work as for Platypus Body. 30 sts

Rnds 5-12: 1dc in each st to end

Note: foll rows make up five legs, and are not worked in the rnd

**** Row 13:** * 1dc in first six sts, turn. Six sts

Row 14: 1ch, 1dc in each st to end, turn

Rows 15-16: 1ch, dc2tog, 1dc in each st to end, turn. Four sts

Row 17: 1ch, 1dc in each st to end, turn

Row 18: 1ch, dc2tog, 1dc in each st to end, turn. Three sts

Row 19: rep Row 17

Row 20: 1ch, dc3tog, turn. One st

Row 21: 1ch, work nine

sl sts evenly along LH side of leg back towards Body. Nine sts *
Rep from * to * four times **
Fasten off

inner legs

Using 3.5mm hook and yellow yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1-4: work as for Platypus Body. 30 sts

Note: foll rows make up five legs, and are not worked in the rnd

Rep from ** to ** of outer legs

Fasten off

to make up

Place two pieces tog and sew along legs with green yarn, adding stuffing to each leg as it is completed. Stuff Body just before sewing up last leg. Embroider mouth. Sew on beads for eyes

body & head

Using 3.5mm hook and orange yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1-12: 2dc in first st, 1dc in each st to end. 18 sts

Rnds 13-16: 1dc in each st to end

Stuff

Rnd 17: (dc2tog, 1dc in next st) to end. 12 sts

Rnd 18: (dc2tog) to end. Six sts
Fasten off

outer ears

Make two

Using 3.5mm hook and orange yarn make a magic ring and work 5dc into ring. Five sts

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. Ten sts

Rnd 2: (1dc in next st, 2dc in next st) to end. 15 sts

Fasten off

inner ears

Make two

Using 3.5mm hook and blue yarn make a magic ring and work 5dc into ring. Five sts

Fasten off

tail

Using 3.5mm hook and blue yarn make 27ch

Rnd 1: starting second ch from hook, sl st into top loop of each ch to end
Fasten off

to make up

Sew up end of Body. Roll up Outer Ears and sew to Head. Roll up Inner Ears and sew inside Outer Ears. Sew Tail to Body. Embroider Nose with blue yarn. Sew on beads for Eyes

Kitty cat head

* Using 3.5mm hook and white yarn make a magic ring and work 7dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 14 sts

Rnd 2: (1dc in next st, 2dc in next st) to end. 21 sts

Rnd 3: (1dc in next two sts, 2dc in next st) to end. 28 sts *

Rnds 4-8: 1dc in each st to end

****Rnd 9:** (1dc in next two sts, dc2tog) to end. 21 sts

Rnd 10: (1dc in next st, dc2tog) to end, join with a sl st to next st

Cut yarn and fasten off **

body

Using 3.5mm hook and white yarn make a magic ring and work 7dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnds 1-2: work as for Head

Rnds 3-6: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 7: 2dc, dc2tog, 2dc, dc2tog, 5dc, (dc2tog, 2dc) twice. 17 sts

Rnd 8: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 9: dc2tog, 13dc, dc2tog. 15 sts

Rnd 10: rep Rnd 8

Rnd 11: dc2tog, 13dc. 14 sts

ears

Make two

Using 3.5mm hook and pink yarn make a magic ring and work 4dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnds 1-2: (1dc in next st, 2dc into next st) to end. Nine sts

Rnd 3: (1dc in next two sts, 2dc into next st) to end. 12 sts

Rnd 4: 1dc in each st to end, join with a sl st to next st

Cut yarn and fasten off

hind legs

Make two

Using 3.5mm hook and white yarn make a magic ring and work 5dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnds 1-6: 1dc in each st to end, join with a sl st to next st

Cut yarn and fasten off

front legs & tail

Make three

Work as for Hind Legs, but working one extra rnd of dc at end before cutting yarn

to make up

Fix safety eyes to Head below Rnd 5. Space eyes approx 1cm apart. Stuff Head and Body firmly. Sew Head to Body. Sew Ears to top of Head. Lightly stuff legs. Sew Hind Legs to either side of lower Body. Sew front legs to the top of Body. Sew Tail to back of Body. Thread a bell to a thin strip of ribbon and tie around neck

Daphne ducking head

Using yellow yarn work as for Kitty cat from * to *. 28 sts

Rnd 4: (1dc in next three sts, 2dc into next st) to end. 35 sts **

Rnds 5-10: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 11: (1dc in next three sts, dc2tog) to end. 28 sts

Work as for Kitty cat Head from ** to **

body

Using yellow yarn work as for Kitty cat Head from * to *. 28 sts

Rnds 4-8: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 9: (1dc in next two sts, dc2tog) to end. 21 sts

Rnds 10-12: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 13: (1dc in next st, dc2tog) to end. 14 sts

Rnds 14-15: 1dc in each st to end, join with a sl st to next st

Cut yarn and fasten off

wings

Make two

Using 3.5mm hook and orange yarn make a magic ring and work 4dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. Eight sts

Rnd 2: (1dc in next st, 2dc into next st) to end. 12 sts

Rnds 3-7: 1dc in each st to end, join with a sl st to next st

Cut yarn and fasten off

feet

Make two

* Using 3.5mm hook and orange yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to



crochet clever

The pieces of Lynne's toys are all worked in a continuous spiral. Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of every round

Body. Fix safety eyes to crocheted eyes and lightly stuff. Sew eyes to top of Head. Sew a mouth with contrasting yarn. Cut a small heart shape from green felt and sew to Body, just off centre

Derek donut

Using 3.5mm hook and pink yarn make 20ch, join with a sl st to first ch, make 1ch

Rnd 1: 1dc in each ch to end. 20 sts

Rnd 2: (1dc in next st, 2dc into next st) to end. 30 sts

Rnds 3-4: rep Rnds 1-2. 45 sts

Rnd 5: rep Rnd 1
Cut pink yarn, join in blue yarn

Rnds 6-10: rep Rnd 1
Cut blue yarn, join in pink yarn

Rnd 11: (1dc, dc2tog) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 12: rep Rnd 1

Rnd 13: rep Rnd 11. 20 sts

Rnd 14: rep Rnd 1
Cut yarn and fasten off

end. 12 sts *

Rnds 2-6: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 7: (dc2tog) to end, join with a sl st to next st
Cut yarn and fasten off

beak

Work as for Feet from * to *.

12 sts

Rnd 2: 1dc, 2dc in next st, 1tr in next st, 2tr in next st, (1dc in next st, 2dc in next st) twice, 1tr in next st, 2tr in next st, 1dc in next st, 2dc in next st, join with a sl st to next st

Cut yarn and fasten off

to make up

Cut two circles of orange felt slightly larger than safety eyes. Use a tapestry needle to make a small hole in the centre of each felt circle. Push safety eyes through hole then fix eyes to Head at Rnd 7. Space Eyes approx 4cm apart. Stuff Head and Body. Sew Head to Body. Sew Wings to each side of Body and sew Feet to underside of lower Body. Sew Beak to Head just below eyes. Cut a 10 cm length of orange yarn and fold in half. Insert crochet hook into a stitch on top

of Head and out through next stitch. Hook folded end of yarn and pull through sts for approx 2cm. Hook cut ends of yarn and pull through folded end to create a knot. Pull tight and trim cut end. Cut a small heart shape from orange felt and sew to Body, just off centre

Freda frog

Using green yarn throughout, work Head and Body as for Daphne Duckling

eyes

Make two

Using 3.5mm hook and white yarn make a magic ring and work 7dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 14 sts

Rnds 2-3: 1dc in each st to end, join with a sl st to next st
Cut yarn and fasten off

legs

Using 3.5mm hook and green yarn make a magic ring and work 7dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnds 1-12: 1dc in each st to end
Cut green yarn, join in white yarn

Rnd 13: 1dc in next two sts, 2dc in next two sts, 1dc in next three sts. Nine sts

Rnd 14: 1dc in next three sts, (1tr, 1dtr, 1tr, one sl st) in each of next three sts, 1dc in next three sts, join with a sl st to next st
Cut yarn and fasten off

arms

Make two

Using 3.5mm hook and white yarn make a magic ring and work 7dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnd 1: (1dc in next st, 2dc into next st) three times, 1dc. Ten sts

Rnds 2-3: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 4: (dc2tog) to end. Five sts

Rnds 5-6: rep Rnd 2-3
Cut white yarn, join in green yarn

Rnds 7-10: rep Rows 2-3 twice
Cut yarn and fasten off

to make up

Stuff Head and Body. Sew Head to Body. Stuff Arms and sew to each side of Body. Lightly stuff Legs, squash foot flat so that three groups of treble sts are at front. Sew foot seam closed then sew Legs to lower

to make up

Fix eyes 1cm apart between Rnds 3-4. Sew a mouth with contrasting yarn. Sew Rnds 1 and 14 tog using over sew. Stuff as you sew. Add beads to top

Clara cupcake

Using pink yarn work as for Daphne duckling Head to **

Rnd 5: (1dc in next four sts, 2dc in next st) to end. 42 sts

Rnd 6: 1dc in back loop only of each st to end

Rnds 7-10: 1dc in each st to end

Cut pink yarn, join in orange yarn

Rnd 11: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 12: rep Rnd 6

Rnd 13: (1dc in next four sts, dc2tog) to end. 35 sts

Rnd 14: (1dc in next three sts, dc2tog) to end. 28 sts

Tie off and cut all loose yarn ends inside cake (except for working yarn).

Affix two safety eyes to side of cake, approx 1cm apart. Cut a circle of cardboard to fit top of cake. Place cardboard inside cake top. Stuff cake

Rnd 15: (2dc, dc2tog) to end. 21 sts

Rnd 16: (1dc, dc2tog) to end. 14 sts

Stuff cake until firm

Rnd 17: (dc2tog) to end, join with a sl st to next st

Cut yarn and fasten off

Sew a red yarn mouth to cake side, below eyes

swirly cream

Using blue yarn work as for Kitty cat Head from * to *

Turn work so back of disc is facing you



Work 4dc in back loop only of each st around, join with a sl st to first dc. Cut yarn and fasten off

cherry

Using 3.5mm hook and pink yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnds 2-3: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 4: (dc2tog) to end. Six sts

Cut yarn and fasten off

to make up

Firmly stuff cherry. Thread cut yarn end onto wool needle and gather sts closed. Cut a 10cm length of orange yarn. Tie three knots at one end. Thread through cherry from bottom to top using knots as anchor. Cut yarn to size. Sew cherry to centre of cream then sew cream to cake top

Timmy teacup mug

* Using 3.5mm hook and blue yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring. Pull ring tight to close hole

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnd 2: (1dc in next st, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts

Rnd 3: (1dc in next two sts, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 4: (1dc in next three sts, 2dc in next st) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 5: (1dc in next four sts, 2dc in next st) to end. 36 sts *

Rnds 6-16: 1dc in back loop only of each st, join with a sl st to next st. Cut yarn and fasten off. Sew in ends

tea

Using yellow yarn work as for Mug from * to *. Cut yarn and fasten off

handle

Using 3.5mm hook and blue yarn make 21ch

Row 1: 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in each st to end, 1ch, turn

Row 2: 1dc in each st to end, 1ch, turn. Fold strip in half and join by working 1dc into back loops only of first and second row sts

to make up

Fix eyes approx 1cm apart. Sew a mouth in red yarn. Cut two cardboard circles the same size as base of Mug. Place one circle inside mug to keep bottom flat. Stuff Mug firmly. Place a second circle of cardboard on top of stuffing, then sew circle of Tea to inner top edge of Mug. Using picture as a guide, sew Handle to side of mug. Cut a small tag from pink felt and sew 'TEA' in a contrasting thread. Add a decorative edging stitch to the tea bag and sew to mug with pink yarn



then make 24ch, join with a sl st to first ch, taking care to twist chain

Rnd 1: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next two sts) to end. 32 sts

Rnd 2: 1dc in next seven sts, dc2tog, 1dc in next 14dc, dc2tog, 1dc in next seven sts. 30 sts

Rnd 3: * (1dc, 1tr) in next st, (1tr, 1dc) in next st, sl st in next st, rep from * to end

Fasten off, sew in end

wings

Make two

Using white yarn work as for Legs from * to *. 12 sts

Rnd 2: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 3: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) to end. 18 sts

Rnd 4: rep Rnd 2

Rnd 5: (dc2tog, 1dc in next st) to end. 12 sts

Rnds 6-7: rep Rnd 2

Rnd 8: rep Rnd 5.

Eight sts

Fasten off, sew in ends

to make up

Firmly stuff Head and Body and sew tog using long tail. Do not stuff arms. Attach arms to

Body at shoulders. Stuff the Legs firmly and attach to Body. Sew Skirt to Body and flattened Wings to back. Sew strands of orange yarn onto Head for hair. Using black yarn embroider eyes and mouth

Using 3.5mm hook and yellow yarn work as for Sunflower Fairy Head to end of Rnd 2. 18 sts

Note: work in back loops only for Rnd 3

Rnd 3: 1dc in each st to end

Rnds 4-6: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 7: (dc2tog, 1dc in next four sts) to end. 15 sts

Rnds 8-9: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 10: (dc2tog, 1dc in next three sts) to end. 12 sts

Rnds 11-12: rep Rnds 8-9

Note: work in front loops only for Rnd 13

Rnd 13: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) to end. 18 sts

Sunflower fairy head

* Using 3.5mm hook and pink yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring, pull ring tight to close hole

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnd 2: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) to end. 18 sts

Rnd 3: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next two sts) to end. 24 sts *

Rnds 4-6: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 7: (dc2tog, 1dc in next two sts) to end. 18 sts

Rnd 8: (dc2tog, 1dc in next st) to end. 12 sts
Fasten off, leaving a 30cm tail

body

Using yellow yarn work as for Head from * to *. 24 sts

Rnds 4-9: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 10: (dc2tog, 1dc in next two sts) to end. 18 sts

Rnds 11-12: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 13: (dc2tog, 1dc in next st) to end. 12 sts

Rnd 14: 1dc in each st to end
Fasten off, leaving a short tail

Using 3.5mm hook and pink yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring, pull ring tight to close

Rnd 1: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) to end. Nine sts

Rnd 2: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 3: (dc2tog, 1dc in next st) to end. Six sts.

Rnds 4-7: 1dc in each st to end

Change to yellow yarn

Rnd 8: rep Rnd 1. Nine sts

Rnd 9: rep Rnd 3. Six sts
Fasten off, leaving a 20cm tail

Make two

* Using 3.5mm hook and yellow yarn make a magic ring and work 6dc into ring, pull ring tight to close hole

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts *

Rnds 2-3: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 4: (dc2tog, 1dc in next st) to end. Eight sts

Stuff ends of Feet firmly

Change to pink yarn

Rnds 5-13: 1dc in each st to end

Fasten off, leaving a 20cm tail

Using 3.5mm hook and yellow yarn leave a 30cm length of yarn

Using 3.5mm hook and white yarn make a magic ring and work 8dc into ring, join with a sl st
 Fasten off leaving a 20cm tail

Firmly stuff cap and sew on white spots using yarn tails. Firmly stuff bottom of Stalk, adding a small stone or weight to the bottom to help it stand. Sew Cap to Base. Using black yarn embroider eyes and mouth

 Change to pink yarn
 Rep Rows 5-13 of Sunflower Fairy Legs

Using blue yarn work as for Sunflower Fairy Skirt

wings

Work as for Sunflower Fairy Wings

to make up

Work as for Sunflower Fairy, omitting orange hair. Instead, tie a length of blue yarn in a bow around bun on top of Head

Betty butterfly head & body

Using 3.5mm hook and orange yarn work as for Sunflower Fairy Head to end of Rnd 2. 18 sts

Rnds 3-4: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 5: (dc2tog, 1dc) to end. 12 sts

Stuff Head firmly

Rnd 6: (dc2tog) to end. Six sts

Rnd 7: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 8: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) to end. Nine sts

Rnd 9: rep Rnd 7

Change to green yarn, do not cut orange yarn

Rnds 10-11: rep Rnds 3-4 Change to orange yarn, do not cut green yarn

Using 3.5mm hook and green yarn make 5ch, sl st in same ch on hook, one sl st in each of next three ch, 4dc in final ch

Rnd 7: 1dc in each st

Change to green yarn, fasten off orange yarn
Rnds 8-14: Rep Rnds 8-14 of Sunflower Fairy Body. 12 sts
Fasten off, leaving a short tail

Make two

Using pink yarn work as for Sunflower Fairy Arms to end of Rnd 4. Six sts

Change to green yarn

Note: work in front loops only for Rnd 5

Rnd 5: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) to end. Nine sts

Note: work in back loops only for Rnd 6

Rnd 6: 1dc in each st to end

Rnds 7-9: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 10: (dc2tog, 1dc in next st) to end. Six sts
Fasten off, leaving a 20cm tail

legs

Make two

Using orange yarn work as for Sunflower Fairy Legs to end of Rnd 6. Eight sts

Change to green yarn

Note: work in back loops only for Rnd 7

Rnd 7: 1dc in each st to end

Rnds 8-13: 1dc in each st to end

Fasten off, leaving a 20cm tail

to make up

Work as for Sunflower Fairy but lightly stuff each arm and omit orange hair. Instead, sew a row of yellow stitches below hat for hair

crochet clever

When making the stripy Body for the butterfly, don't cut your yarn. Just twist the new colour around the old one on the inside of the character. You can then carry both yarns up the side to use for the next round
