

SKILL LEVEL

PLUS 6mm hook. tapestry needle, two 9mm safety eyes, stuffing, spare black yarn, stitch markers

SIZE Length: approx 19cm



## BODY

Using 6mm hook and Fluffy White make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts **Rnd 2:** (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts Rnd 3: (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts Rnd 4: (3dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 30 sts Rnd 5: (4dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 36 sts **Rnds 6-7:** 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 8: (dc2tog, 4dc) to end. 30 sts Rnd 9: (dc2tog, 3dc) to end. 24 sts **Rnd 10:** (dc2tog, 2dc) to end. 18 sts Rnd 11: (dc2tog,



We don't know about ewe, but sheep are one of our favourite animals - for obvious reasons! The fluffy yarn in your Bounce yarn kit lends itself perfectly to our woolly friends and in this project, Flora will help you show it off to its fullest. She is made up of several pieces that are worked in the round, and has colourful stripy legs which contrast beautifully with her snow white coat. Start her tonight and you'll have a baarilliant time whipping her up!

### HAIR

Using 6mm hook and Fluffy White make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

### HEAD

Using 3mm hook and Basket Blue make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts Rnd 2 and every even-numbered rnd: 1dc in each st to end Rnd 3: (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts Rnd 5: (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts Note: mark Rnd 7 with a st marker Rnd 7: (3dc, 2dc

#### LIMB Make four

Using 3mm hook and Basket Blue

make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts Rnds 2-3: 1dc in each st to end Rnd 4: (dc2tog, 2dc) to end. Nine sts Work in foll two-rnd stripe sequence: Carrot Orange, Blossom Pink, Chick Yellow, Bud Green Rnds 5-12: 1dc in each st to end Fasten off

EAR

Make two Using 3mm hook and Basket Blue make 5ch, 1dc in second ch from hook, 1htr in each of next two ch, 1tr in next ch. Four sts Fasten off

# TO MAKE UP

Sew in ends. Sew end of Head and Body closed. Sew Head to Body. Sew Hair to top of Head. Stuff Limbs and sew to Body. Sew an Ear to either side of Hair. Embroider nose onto face (see Great Advice panel)





To give Flora a nose and mouth, use spare black yarn or doubled embroidery thread to sew three long stitches in a 'Y' shape

> Safety first If making Flora for a baby or young child, be sure to use safety eyes or embroider them in black yarn instead
