SIZE
Doll:
7cm x 15cm

Hanako
geisha girl

**HEAD
AND BODY**

Using 4mm hook and Doily White make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts

Rnd 2: (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts

Rnd 3: (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 4: (3dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 5: (4dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 36 sts

Rnds 6-10: 1dc in each st to end

Note: mark Rnd 8 with a st marker

Rnd 11: (dc2tog, 4dc) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 12: (dc2tog, 3dc) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 13: (dc2tog, 2dc) to end. 18 sts

Insert safety eyes on marked rnd, approx seven sts apart

Rnd 14: (dc2tog, 1dc) to end. 12 sts

Stuff
Change to Icing Pink

Rnd 15: 1dc in each st to end

Rnds 16-17: rep Rnds 4-5. 18 sts

Rnd 18: (5dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 21 sts

Rnd 19: (6dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 20: (7dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 27 sts

Rnd 21: (8dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 30 sts

Rnd 22: (9dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 33 sts

Rnd 23: (10dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 36 sts

Rnds 24-30: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 31: working in back loops only (dc2tog, 4dc) to end. 30 sts

Rnds 32-33: rep Rnds 12-13. 18 sts

Rnd 34: (dc2tog, 1dc) to end. 12 sts

Stuff

Rnd 35: (dc2tog) to end. Six sts
Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and thread through rem sts, fasten off

SLEEVE

Make two

Using 4mm hook and Icing Pink make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: 2dc in next st, 1dc in each st to end. Seven sts

Rnd 2: 1dc in each st to end

Rnds 3-10: rep Rnds 1-2 four times. 11 sts

Change to China Blue

Rnd 11: rep Rnd 2 Fasten off, leaving a long tail

HAIR

Using 4mm hook and Teapot Blue make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1-5: work as for Rnds 1-5 of Head and Body. 36 sts

Rnd 6: (11dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 39 sts

Rnds 7-8: 1dc in each st to end

Row 9: 30dc, turn

Rows 10-14: 1ch, 30dc, turn

Rows 15-17: work as for Rnds 32-34 of Head and Body, turning at end of each row. 12 sts Fasten off, leaving a long tail

BUN

Make two

Using 4mm hook

and Teapot Blue make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnds 1-2: work as for Rnds 1-2 of Head and Body. 18 sts

Rnds 3-4: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 5: (dc2tog, 1dc) to end. 12 sts

Stuff Fasten off, leaving a long tail

TRIM

Using 4mm hook and China Blue make 35ch Fasten off

FLOWER

Make three

Using 4mm hook



Your Legacy yarn kit is perfect for Liz Ward's lovely project

Dressed in her pretty kimono and wearing a sweet smile, our adorable geisha girl Hanako will be next on your crochet list. With the exception of some of the hair, the pattern is worked in a spiral – so you can well and truly get to grips with amigurumi basics. This technique actually originated in our geisha's home country of Japan, so there's no better project to introduce you to it.

and Macaroon Pink make a magic ring, work (2tr, one sl st) into ring five times. Five petals made Fasten off

TO MAKE UP

Sew Sleeves to Body. Sew Hair to Head. Sew Bun to each side of Hair. Using Icing Pink wrap around each Bun three times and knot at back. Sew Trim to front of Body (see Great Advice panel). Sew one Flower to kimono and two to one Bun. Using Icing Pink to embroider a smile on face





Great Advice

CUTE KIMONO

To attach the China Blue trim to the kimono, join the chain centrally to the bottom, secure approximately seven rounds below the Doily White section then wrap it around the neck and join it at an angle to the front
