# hanging organiser

Display your love of both knitting and crochet in your home with **Sarah Shrimpton's** ingenious wall pocket. It uses a chunky needle at the top and bottom to give it structure and gives you the opportunity to play around with colour combinations when making those eight adorable mini granny squares. To save time, work over the yarn tails as you go, then just snip them off at the end.





1tr), miss one ch, 1tr in each ch to end. 15 sts  
Fasten off, leaving a 20cm tail

### back piece

Using 4mm hook and Bright White make 35ch

**Row 1:** 1ch, 1dc in each ch to end, turn

**Rows 2-4:** 3ch, miss one st, 1tr in each st to end, turn

**Work in foll three-row stripe sequence:** \* Ever

Green, Cranberry Pink, Icicle Blue, Ballerina Pink, Frosty Silver \*, Bright White, rep from \* to \* once

**Rows 5-37:** rep Rows 2-4 11 times

Work in foll one-row stripe sequence: Cranberry Pink, Icicle Blue, Ever Green, Frosty Silver, Cranberry Pink, Ever Green, Icicle Blue, Frosty Silver, Icicle Blue

**Rows 38-46:** 3ch, miss one st, 1tr in each st to

### to make up

Join Mini Granny Squares foll picture as colour guide as folls: hold two squares tog with RS facing, using yarn tail whip st through back loops along one side. **Note:** tail will be long enough to sew along two edges. Cont like this to make two rows of four squares. Position Hanging Loops evenly across top and bottom edges of Back Piece. Using yarn tails sew them in place, allowing enough room to insert needle through. Position Granny Square pockets on Back Piece as shown. Using 4mm hook and Icicle Blue work a dc border around edges of Large Granny Square, ensuring that along side edges you work through both Large Granny Square and Back Piece. Sew bottom edge of pocket to Back Piece. Using Frosty Silver rep border around Mini Granny Square section. Sew in ends





## stitches used

Chain (ch)  
Slip stitch (sl st)  
Double crochet (dc)  
Treble (tr)

### SIZE

Height excl. straps:  
42cm  
Width: 17cm

## hanging organiser

### large granny square

Using 4mm hook and Cranberry Pink make 4ch, join with a sl st to first ch to make a ring  
**Note:** first 3ch of each rnd counts as tr  
**Rnd 1:** 3ch, 2tr into ring, 2ch, (3tr, 2ch) three times, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch, sl st to next 2ch corner sp. 12 sts  
Change to Icicle Blue

**Rnd 2:** \* (3ch, 2tr, 2ch, 3tr, 1ch) in same 2ch corner sp, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr, 1ch) in each of next three 2ch corner sp, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch \*, sl st to next 2ch corner sp. 24 sts  
Work in foll one-row stripe sequence: Bright White, Frosty Silver, Ballerina Pink, Ever Green, Bright White, Cranberry Pink, Ballerina Pink  
**Rnds 3-9:** (3ch, 2tr, 2ch, 3tr, 1ch) in same 2ch corner sp, \* (3tr, 1ch) in each 1ch sp to next 2ch corner sp, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr,

1ch) in 2ch corner sp, rep from \* twice, 3tr in each 1ch sp to end, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch, sl st to next 2ch sp. 108 sts  
Fasten off, sew in ends

### mini granny square

**Make eight**

**Note:** see Crochet Clever for colour instructions. First 3ch of each rnd counts as tr  
Using 4mm hook and chosen yarn make 4ch, join with a sl st to first

ch to make a ring  
**Rnd 1:** rep Rnd 1 of Large Granny Square. 12 sts  
Change to second colour  
**Rnd 2:** rep from \* to \* of Rnd 2 of Large Granny Square. 24 sts  
Fasten off, leaving a 20cm tail

### hanging loop

**Make 12 (two in each colour from Bobble yarn kit)**  
Using 4mm hook and chosen yarn make 15ch  
**Row 1:** 3ch (counts as

When working the mini granny squares, work them in the following colourways: Cranberry Pink and Ever Green, Icicle Blue and Cranberry Pink, Bright White and Ballerina Pink, Ever Green and Bright White, Icicle Blue and Frosty Silver, Ballerina Pink and Icicle Blue, Bright White and Cranberry Pink, Frosty Silver and Ever Green
