## ALPACA hat

Using 4mm  
needles and  
Mermaid Tail cast  
on 28 sts

**Rows 1-2:** k

**Rows 3-14:**  
starting with a  
k row work in  
st st

**Row 15:** (k2tog)  
to end, 14 sts

**Row 16:** (p2tog)  
to end.

Seven sts  
Cut yarn leaving  
a long tail, thread  
tail onto  
tapestry needle  
and thread  
through rem  
sts, fasten off

### muzzle

Using 4mm  
needles and  
Seaweed Green  
cast on 16 sts  
**Rows 1-5:** rep  
Rows 11-15 of Hat.  
Eight sts  
Cut yarn leaving  
a long tail, thread  
tail onto tapestry  
needle and thread  
through rem sts,  
fasten off

### ear

**Make two**  
Using 4mm  
needles and  
Mermaid Tail cast  
on five sts

**Rows 1-5:** starting  
with a k row work  
in st st

**Row 6:** p2tog, p1,  
p2tog. Three sts  
Change to  
Seaweed Green  
**Rows 7-11:** rep  
Rows 1-5  
Cast off pwise

### to make up

\* Seam row edges  
of Hat and Muzzle.  
Stuff Muzzle  
lightly and sew  
cast-on edge to  
front of Hat. Using  
black DK  
embroider a nose  
on Muzzle and  
eyes on Hat. Fold

Ears in half so  
cast-on and  
cast-off edges  
meet. Sew row  
edges. Oversew  
across cast-on  
and cast-off edge.  
Fold edge in place  
and secure with a  
few sts. Sew to  
Hat \*. Attach 8cm  
lengths of  
Himalayan Salt  
between Ears and  
trim. Weave in  
all ends

### PROTEST HAT

Using 4mm  
needles and  
Jellyfish Pink

cast on 15 sts  
**Row 1:** (k1, p1) to  
last st, k1

**Row 2:** (p1, k1) to  
last st, p1

**Rows 3-6:** rep  
Rows 1-2 twice

**Rows 7-26:**  
starting with a k  
row work in st st

**Rows 27-32:** rep

Rows 1-2 three  
times  
Cast off

### to make up

Fold in half so  
cast-on and  
cast-off edges  
meet. Sew row  
edges. Weave in  
all ends

## WHALE hat

Using 4mm needles and Dolphin Blue work as for Alpaca Hat

### tail

Using 4mm needles and Dolphin Blue cast on five sts

**Row 1:** k

**Row 2 and every even-numbered row:** p

**Row 3:** (k1, m1) to last st, k1. Nine sts

**Row 5:** k

**Row 7:** k4, yfwd, k2tog, k3

**Row 9:** k

**Row 11:** (k2tog) to last st, k1. Five sts  
Cast off

### fin

#### Make two

Using 4mm needles and Dolphin Blue cast on eight sts  
**Rows 1-5:** starting with a k row work in st st  
Cut yarn leaving

a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and thread through rem sts, fasten off

### to make up

Seam row edges of Hat. Fold Tail in half so cast-on and cast-off edges meet. Seam row edges and oversew cast-on and cast-off edges. Sew Tail to back of Hat. Seam row edges of Fins. Fold cast-on edge in half and oversew. Sew Fins on either side of Hat. Using black DK embroider two eyes on front. Sew pom-poms in 'Y' shape, sew to top of Hat. Weave in all ends

## TOP HAT hat

Using 4mm needles and Mermaid Tail cast on 28 sts

**Rows 1-4:** k

Change to Jellyfish Pink

**Rows 5-12:** starting with a k row work in st st

**Row 13:** (kfb, k3)

to end. 35 sts

**Rows 14-16:** p

**Row 17:** (k3, k2tog) to end. 28 sts

**Row 18:** p

**Row 19:** (k2, k2tog) to end. 21 sts

**Row 20:** p

**Row 21:** (k1, k2tog) to end. 14 sts

**Row 22:** (p2tog) to end. Seven sts

Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and thread through rem sts, fasten off

### brim

Using 4mm needles and Jellyfish Pink cast on 28 sts

**Row 1:** k

**Row 2:** (kfb) to end. 56 sts

**Rows 3-5:** k

Cast off

### to make up

Seam row edges of Hat and Brim. Sew cast-on edge of Brim to cast-on edge of Hat. Weave in all ends

## UNICORN hat

Using 4mm needles and Himalayan Salt work as for Alpaca Hat

### muzzle

Using 4mm needles and Himalayan Salt work as for Alpaca Muzzle

### ear

#### Make two

Using 4mm needles and Himalayan Salt work as for Alpaca Ear, ignoring colour changes

### horn

Using 4mm needles and Dolphin Blue cast on five sts

**Rows 1-8:** starting with a k row work in st st

**Row 9:** k2tog, k1, k2tog. Three sts  
Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry

needle and thread through rem sts, fasten off

### to make up

Rep from \* to \* of Alpaca To Make Up. Seam row edges of Horn and

stuff lightly, sew to top of Hat. Embroider a swirl down length of Horn using Seaweed Green. Use 8cm lengths of all colours except Himalayan Salt to work three lines of mane down back of Hat. Weave in all ends
