YARN
Sirdar Happy
Cotton DK,
shades (A) 776
Biscuit, five 25g
balls, (B) 761 Dolly, two 25g balls, (C) 760 Flamingo, (D) 780 Treetop, (E) 795 Giggle, (F) 793 Sorbet, (G) 787
Sundae, (H) 797 Bunting, one 25 g ball of each, small amount of black cotton DK

PLUS
3.5 mm hook,
stitch marker,
two 10 mm safety
eyes, safety toy
stuffing, tapestry needle

SIZE 20cm tall

Perfect for beginners

CAT
body
Using 3.5 mm hook and yarn A make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts
Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts Rnd 2: (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts
Rnd 3: (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts
Rnd 4: (3dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 30 sts
Rnd 5: (4dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 36 sts
Rnd 6: (5dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 42 sts
Rnd 7: (6dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 48 sts

This delightful crocheted kitty looks so serene in her splendid flower-power crown. Designed by SARAH REED, Blossom is the perfect size to sit on your desk or shelf reminding you to keep calm and crochet on. Leave a tail when you fasten off each piece to make sewing together easier, and make the colour changes more seamless by using an invisible join and then rejoining the next colour onto the piece.

Rnd 8: (7dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 54 sts
Rnd 9: (8dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 60 sts
Rnd 10: (9dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 66 sts
Rnd 11: (10dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 72 sts
Rnds 12-19: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 20: (10dc, dc2tog) to end. 66 sts
Rnds 21-25: 1dc in each st to end Rnd 26: (9dc, dc2tog) to end. 60 sts
Rnds 27-31: 1dc in
each st to end
Rnd 32: (8dc,
dc2tog) to end.
54 sts
Rnds 33-35: 1dc in
each st to end
Rnd 36: (7dc,
dc2tog) to end. 48 sts
Rnds 37-39: 1dc in
each st to end
Rnd 40: (6dc,
dc2tog) to end. 42 sts
Rnds 41-43: 1dc in
each st to end
Rnd 44: (5dc,
dc2tog) to
end. 36 sts
Fasten off

## head

Using 3.5 mm hook and yarn A make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring.

## Six sts

Rnds 1-10: work as
for Rnds 1-10 of Body. 66 sts
Rnds 11-22: 1dc in
each st to end
Rnd 23: (9dc,
dc2tog) to end. 60 sts
Rnd 24: (8dc, dc2tog) to end. 54 sts
Rnd 25: (7dc, dc2tog) to end. 48 sts
Rnd 26: (6dc, dc2tog) to end. 42 sts
Rnd 27: (5dc,
dc2tog) to
end. 36 sts Fasten off

## muzzle

Using 3.5 mm hook and yarn B make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts
Rnds 1-3: work as Rnds 1-3 of Body. 24 sts
Rnds 4-5: 1dc in each st to end Fasten off

## outer ear

## Make two

Using 3.5 mm hook and yarn A make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring.

## Six sts

Rnd 1: 1dc in each
st to end
Rnd 2: (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. Nine sts
Rnd 3: 1dc in each
st to end
Rnd 4: (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 12 sts
Rnd 5: 1dc in each
st to end
Rnd 6: (3dc, 2dc in
next st) to end. 15 sts
Rnd 7: 1dc in each
st to end
Fasten off
inner ear
Make two
Using 3.5 mm hook
and yarn C
make 5ch
Row 1: beg in
second ch from
hook, 1dc in each st to end, turn. Four sts
Row 2: 1ch (does
not count as st throughout),
dc2tog, 1dc in each to end, turn.
Three sts
Row 3: 1ch, dc2tog,
1dc, turn. Two sts
Row 4: 1ch, dc2tog.
One st
Fasten off
chest
Using 3.5 mm hook and yarn $B$
make 4ch
Row 1: beg in
second ch from
hook, 1dc in each st to end, turn.
Three sts
Row 2: 1ch (does
not count as st
throughout), 2dc in each st to end, turn. Six sts
Row 3: 1ch, (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end, turn. Nine sts
Row 4: 1ch, (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end, turn. 12 sts
Rows 5-24: 1ch, 1dc
in each st to end, turn
Row 25: 1ch, (2dc, dc2tog) to end, turn. Nine sts
Rows 26-30: 1ch, 1dc in each st to end, turn
Row 31: 1ch, (1dc, dc2tog) to end, turn. Six sts
Rows 32-33: 1ch,
1dc in each st to end, turn
Row 34: 1ch,
(dc2tog) to end,
turn. Three sts

Row 35: 1ch,
dc3tog, turn.
One st
Fasten off
frontleg
Make two
Using 3.5 mm hook and yarn B make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts
Rnd 1: 2dc in each
st to end. 12 sts
Rnd 2: (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts Rnd 3: 5dc, (BO, 1dc) four
times, 5dc
Rnd 4: 1dc in each st to end
Change to yarn A
Rnds 5-13: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 14: (5dc, 2dc in
next st) to end. 21 sts

## crochet



Rnds 1-75: 1dc in
each st to end Fasten off
rose
Make six, three in each colour Using 3.5 mm hook and yarn C (E)
make 23ch
Row 1: 3tr in fourth ch from hook, (miss 1ch, 3tr in next st) to end. 30 sts Fasten off Roll piece to create Rose and secure with a st

## bluebell

Make three
Using 3.5 mm hook and yarn H make 25ch

## Row 1: beg in

second ch from hook, 1dc, (2dc in next st) to end. 47 sts
Fasten off Twist piece to create bluebell shape

Legs using picture as guide. Position Front Legs so that Cat can stand and sew onto Body, with top of Legs approx two rows down from top of Body. If desired, to secure closer to Body, add a couple of sts behind Legs. Stuff Tail well, position at centre back and sew onto Body. Stuff Body firmly. Position Muzzle in centre and towards bottom of face, leaving last two rnds of Head visible. Stuff Muzzle and sew onto face. Place eyes either side of Muzzle so centre of eye is in line
with top of Muzzle and approx two sts from Muzzle on each side. Use photo as a guide for embroidery. Using yarn C, embroider nose. Split black cotton DK in half and embroider whiskers. Sew Outer Ears on fourth st from top of Head and then attach Inner Ears. Stuff Head well and sew onto Body with Muzzle in line with Chest. Weave in all ends

## FLOWER CROWN

base
Using 3.5 mm hook and yarn D make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring Six sts
daisy
Make six, three in each colourway Using 3.5 mm hook and yarn G make a magic ring, work 5dc into ring and join with sl st to first st. Five sts Change to yarn B (F)
Rnd 1: (3ch, 1tr, 3ch,
sl st ) in first st, * ( sl
st, 3ch, 1tr, 3ch, sl st)
in next st, rep from * to end. Five petals made Fasten off

## to make up

Sew short ends of Base tog. Sew flowers onto crown in foll order (from left to right)

* yarn A Rose, yarn B Daisy, yarn C Rose, yarn F Daisy, Bluebell, rep from
* twice more. Weave in all ends
