NEED

Fontaine
yarn kit
tapestry needle

stitches used

Chain (ch)
Slip stitch (sl st)
Double crochet (dc)
Half treble (htr)
Treble (tr)

SIZE

Diameter: 11.5cm

flower coaster

Using 4.5mm hook and chosen yarn make 4ch join with a sl st to form a ring

Rnd 1: 3ch, 1tr into ring, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch. 12 sts

Fasten off first yarn, join second yarn with a sl st to any sp between tr

Rnd 2: (3ch, 1tr) in same sp, 1ch, (2tr in next sp, 1ch) to end, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch. 24 sts

Fasten off second yarn, join third yarn with a sl st to any 1ch sp

Rnd 3: (3ch, 2tr) in same sp, (3tr in next 1ch sp) to end, join with a sl st to third of first 3ch. 36 sts

Fasten off third yarn, join fourth yarn with a sl st between any two 3tr cl

Rnd 4: (3ch, 1dc between next two 3tr cl) to end. 12 sts

Fasten off fourth yarn, join fifth yarn with a sl st to any 3ch sp

Rnd 5: (1dc, 1htr, 2tr, 1htr, 1dc) in each 3ch sp to end. 72 sts

Fasten off, sew in ends
