Perfect for beginners

OWL SOUARE owl

Using 4mm hook and Fluffu make a magic ring, work 8dc into ring. Eight sts

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 16 sts **Rnd 2:** (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts

Rnd 3: (3dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 30 sts Change to Rich Purple

Rnd 4: (4dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 36 sts

Rnd 5: 3ch (counts as first tr), 1tr in same st, 3ch, 2tr in next st, (2htr, 5dc, 2htr, [2tr, 3ch, 2tr] in next st) three times, 2htr, 5dc, 2htr, join with a sl st to top of first ch. 52 sts

Rnd 6: 3ch, ([2tr, 3ch, 2tr] in next st, 13tr) four times, 12htr, join with a sl st to top of first ch. 68 sts, four 3ch sps Fasten off

eye Make two

Using 4mm hook and Black make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts Change to Bright Yellow Rnd 1: 2dc in each

st to end. 12 sts Fasten off, leaving a long tail

CLASSIC SQUARE

Using 4mm hook and Blush Pink make 4ch, join with a sl st to first ch to make a ring Rnd 1: sl st into ring, 3ch, 2tr into ring, 3ch, (3tr into ring, 3ch) three

times, join with a sl st to top of first 3ch. 12 sts, four 3ch sps Change to Rich Purnle

Rnd 2: 3ch, (2tr, 3ch, 3tr) in same sp (first corner made), ([3tr, 3ch, 3tr] in next 3ch sp) (second corner made) three times, join with a sl st to top of first 3ch. 24 sts, four 3ch sps Change to Merry Red Rnd 3: 3ch, (2tr,

3ch, 3tr) in same sp, (3tr in sp between Rnd 2 clusters, [3tr, 3ch, 3tr] in next 3ch sp) three times, 3tr in sp between Rnd 2 clusters, join with a sl st to top of first 3ch. 36 sts, four 3ch sps Fasten off

to make up

Attach Eyes to Owl just above centre of fluffy centre circle. Use Black to embroider a

beak and wings. Use **Bright Yellow** to embroider two sets of toes. Weave in all ends
