

# Practise your increasing and decreasing by creating fun juggling balls

Whether your kids love to play circus acts or hopscotch, bean bag style juggling balls have a number of uses. Crochet these ones together using simple increases and decreases to create a quick and fun gift for a little one, adapting the decorations to their own tastes.

## Stitches used:

Magic ring  
Slip stitch (sl st)  
Chain (ch)  
Double crochet (dc)  
Double crochet two together (dc2tog)  
Half treble (htr)

**Rounds 5-9:** Work five rounds of dc without any increases.  
**Round 10:** [dc2tog, dc in next 3 dc] around. (24 sts).  
**Round 11:** [dc2tog, dc in next 2 dc] around. (18 sts).  
**Round 12:** [dc2tog, dc in next dc] around. (12 sts). Fill the ball with dried beans.

**Round 13:** dc2tog around. (6 sts). Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail and thread onto a tapestry needle. Pass through the remaining stitches and pull tight. Fasten off.

## juggling balls

With a 3.5mm hook and coloured yarn, make a magic ring and work 6 dc into the centre.

**Round 1:** 2 dc in ea dc around. (12 sts).

**Round 2:** [2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc] around. (18 sts).

**Round 3:** [2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next 2 dc] around. (24 sts).

**Round 4:** [2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next 3 dc] around. (30 sts).

## hot tip

Make sure your beans are large enough to not poke through the stitches!



### dots

With a 3.5mm hook and coloured yarn, make a magic ring and work 6 dc into the centre.

(Fasten off here for a tiny dot).

**Round 1:** 2 dc in each dc around. (12 sts).

(Fasten off here for medium dot).

**Round 2:** [2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc] around. (18 sts).

(Fasten off here for large dot).

Sew the dots onto the juggling ball using the tails.

### flowers

#### make 3

With a 3.5mm hook and coloured yarn, make a magic ring and work 10 dc into the centre.

Sl st into first st.

\*2 ch, 1 htr, 1 tr into next stitch, sl st into next.\* Rep from \* to \* four more times.

Fasten off.

Sew the flowers onto the juggling ball using the tails.

into centre hole. Fasten off and use tails to sew onto the juggling ball.

### hearts

With a 3.5mm hook and coloured yarn, make a magic ring and ch 2.

Into the magic ring, 3 htr, 4 dc, 1 htr, 4 dc, 3 htr. Pull the magic ring closed and tease out the shape of the heart. 1 ch and sl st
