



Stitches used:

Chain (ch) Slip stitch (sl st) Double crochet (dc) Treble (tr) Treble two together (tr2tog)

Size:

Length from toe to heel: approx 12cm

baby bootees

ankle sock

Note: bootees are crocheted top downwards, starting with ankle and ending with sole Using 3.5mm hook and blue yarn make 30ch, join with a sl st to form a ring, insert st marker to indicate beg of rnd

Rnd 1: 2ch, 1dc in second ch from hook, (1dc in next ch) 29 times. sl st to second ch

Rnd 2: 3ch, 2tr in next dc, (miss two dc, 3tr in next dc) nine times, sl st to third of first 3ch Fasten off blue yarn, join green yarn to first tr of prev rnd

Rnd 3: 3ch, 2tr in same sp, (miss two tr, 3tr in next tr) nine times, sl st to third of first 3ch

* Fasten off green yarn, join purple yarn to first tr of prev rnd

Rnd 4: rep Rnd 3 * Fasten off purple yarn, join blue yarn to first tr of prev rnd

Rnd 5: rep Rnd 3 Fasten off blue yarn, join green yarn to first tr of prev rnd

Rnd 6: rep Rnd 3 Rep from * to * once

instep

Rejoin purple yarn to first tr of fifth tr cluster from st marker Rows 1-6: 3ch, (1tr in next

tr) eight times Fasten off purple yarn, join blue yarn to back of ankle sock at centre tr of 3tr that lie above st marker

sides & sole

Rnd 1: 3ch, (1tr in next tr) to instep. (2tr over next tr) six times along side of instep, (1tr in next tr) seven times along top

edge, 1tr in third ch, 2tr over 3ch, (2tr over next tr) five times along side of instep, (1tr in next tr) to end, sl st to third of first 3ch

Fasten off blue yarn, join green yarn to third ch

Rnd 2: 3ch. 1tr in next tr. tr2tog, (1tr in next tr) 18 times, tr2tog, (1tr in next tr) four times, tr2tog, (1tr in next tr) 18 times, tr2tog, 1tr in next tr, sI st to third of first 3ch

Fasten off green yarn, join purple yarn to third ch

Rnd 3: 3ch, tr2tog, (1tr in next tr) 18 times, tr2tog, (1tr in next tr) twice, tr2tog, (1tr in next tr) 18 times, tr2tog, sl st to third of first 3ch Fasten off purple yarn, join blue yarn to third ch Rnd 4: 3ch, tr2tog, (1tr in next tr) 17 times, (tr2tog)

twice, (1tr in next tr) 7 times, tr2tog, sl st to third of first 3ch Fasten off, leaving a 30cm tail Thread tail through tapestry needle and sew

centre sole seam closed

leaf

Using 3.5mm hook and green yarn make 4ch Row 1: 2tr in first ch Row 2: 2ch, insert hook into next tr, yoh and pull through loop, insert hook into fourth ch. voh and pull through loop, yoh and draw through all loops on hook Fasten off

flower

Using 3.5mm hook and orange yarn make 5ch, join with a sl st to form a ring

Rnd 1: 2ch, 11dc into ring, sl st to second of first 2ch Fasten off orange yarn,

join blue yarn to one do Rnd 2: [2ch, (1tr, 1dtr) into same dc. 1ch. (1dtr. 1tr) into next dc, one sl st into next dc] six times Fasten off

to make up

Sew two leaves to instep, then sew flower between them

crochet clever

The neatest way to change colour in crochet is part way through a stitch. Work until you have two loops left on your hook, drop the old yarn then take up the new yarn. Fold it round the hook and draw this loop through the two stitches left on the hook
