FOR ABBREVIATIONS
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Keeping eggs warm couldn't be more enjoyable with these marvellous makes from Liz Ward and Lucinda Ganderton. The bobble hats are courtesy of Lucinda, while Liz's adorable animals will make breakfast time entertaining for the whole family. Both styles are made with a magic ring to start, followed by a series of double crochet stitches to produce the basic cosy shape. Create a menagerie of creatures using Liz's body pattern as a starting point, before adding distinguishing features.

BOBBLE HATS

Make three

Using 4mm hook and Calypso (Limeade, Popcorn) make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts
Rnd 1: 1ch, 2dc in each st to end, join with a sl st to first st. 12 sts
Rnd 2: 1ch, (1dc, 2dc in next

st) to end, join with a sl st to first st. 18 sts

Rnd 3: 1ch, 1dc in each st to end, join with a sl st to first st

Rnd 4: 1ch, (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end, join with a sl st to first st. 24 sts

Note: for third Egg Cosy change to Citron after Rnd 5 and Calypso after Rnd 8

Rnds 5-10: rep Rnd 3 six times
Change to Popcorn (Calypso, Limeade)
Rnd 11: 1ch, (3dc, 2dc in next st) to end, join with a sl st to first st. 30 sts
Rnds 12-16: rep Rnd 3 five times
Fasten off

To make up

Sew in ends, make a 3cm pom-pom in Calypso (Limeade, Popcorn) and sew to top

QUIRKY COSIES

Body

Make three

** Using 4mm hook and Milky (Citron, Calypso) make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st to end. 12 sts
Rnd 2: (1dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 18 sts **
Rnd 3: 1dc in each st to end
Rnd 4: (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts
Rnds 5-10: 1dc in each st to end
Fasten off

Head

Make three

Rep from ** to ** of Body. 18 sts
Rnd 3: (2dc, 2dc in next st) to end. 24 sts
Rnds 4-6: 1dc in each st to end

Rnd 7: (dc2tog, 2dc) to end. 18 sts
Rnd 8: (dc2tog, 1dc) to end. 12 sts
Stuff
Rnd 9: (dc2tog) to end.

Six sts
Rnd 10: (dc2tog) to end.
Three sts
Fasten off
Use yarn tail to sew hole closed

Chick wing

Make two

Using 4mm hook and Citron make 5ch

Rnd 1: sl st in second ch from hook, 1dc in next ch, 1htr in next ch, 3tr in next ch, working down opposite side of ch work as follows: 1htr, 1dc, join with a sl st to first st. Seven sts
Fasten off

Lamb hair tuft

Using 4mm hook and Milky make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring. Six sts

Rnd 1: rep Rnd 1 of Body. 12 sts. Fasten off

Lamb ear

Using 4mm hook and Popcorn make 4ch
Rnd 1: 1dc in second ch from hook, 1tr in next ch, 1tr in next ch. Three sts
Fasten off

Bunny ear

Make two
Using 4mm hook and

Calypso make 12ch
Rnd 1: 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in each of next nine ch, 3dc in next ch, working down opposite side of ch work as follows:
10dc. 23 sts
Rnd 2: 1ch, turn, 10dc, 2dc in each of next three sts,
10dc. 26 sts
Fasten off

To make up

Sew in ends. Stitch Heads onto matching Bodies.
Chick: sew Wings to sides of Body. Knot strands of Citron at top of Head. * Cut two 5mm black felt circles for eyes and glue in place *. Cut two 1cm orange felt triangles for beak and glue in place.

Lamb: sew Hair Tuft to top of Head. Stitch Ears to Head. Work as for Chick from * to *. Using grey thread embroider nose as shown.

Bunny: sew Ears to top of Head. Work as for Chick from * to *. Using brown thread embroider nose and mouth as shown **MIT**

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THE LOW-DOWN: MAKING MINI POM-POMS



1 Wrap yarn around the prongs of a fork approximately 60 times.



2 Cut a length of yarn and tie it tightly around the wrapped yarn, between the middle prongs.



3 Slip the yarn off the fork and snip through all the loops.



4 Fluff up the pom-pom and trim any uneven strands.
