

We have six special designs for you this issue. **Helen's Ardley's** stripy treble isn't strictly a granny square but both this and **Christine Harvey's** square are super simple with only three stitches needed, making them ideal for beginners and great as fillers for your finished make.

Whip up these six from your kit and grab yarn from your stash to create more. Remember, after you've collected all the patterns you can decide what you'd like to create with them. single colour basic

Using 4mm hook and Apple Green make 4ch, join with a sl st to form a ring

Rnd 1: 2ch (counts as 1tr), 2tr into ring, (1ch, 3tr into ring) three times, 1ch, join with a sl st to second of first 2ch, 36 sts

Rnd 2: 2ch (counts as 1tr), (3tr in next 1ch sp, 1ch, 3tr in same sp) three times, 3tr in next 1ch sp, 1ch, 2tr in same sp, join with a sl st to second of first 2ch, 24 sts

Rnd 3: 2ch (counts as 1tr), 2tr in same sp, (3tr

in next corner 1ch sp, 1ch, 3tr in same sp, 3tr in next sp) three times, 3tr in next corner sp, 1ch, 3tr in same sp, join with a sl st to second of first 2ch, 36 sts

Rnd 4: 2ch (counts as 1tr), (3tr in next sp, 3tr in next 1ch corner sp, 1ch, 3tr in same sp, 3tr in next sp) three times, 3tr in next sp, 3tr in next 1ch corner sp, 1ch, 3tr in same sp, 2tr in next sp, join with a sl st to second of first 2ch, 48 sts

Fasten off, sew in ends

circle square

Using 4mm hook and Apple Green make a magic ring, work 6dc into ring, join with a sl st to first st. Six sts

Rnd 1: 1ch, (2dc) in each st to end, join with a sl st to first st to first 12 sts

Change to Plum Purple **Rnd 2:** 4ch (counts as 1tr, 1ch), miss one st, (1tr in next st, 1ch) to end, join with a sl st to third of first 4ch

Rnd 3: 1ch, 1dc in each 1ch sp and tr to end, join with a sl st to first st, 24 sts

Change to Soft Blue **Rnds 4–5:** rep Rnds 2–3.

48 sts
Change to Apple Green

Rnd 6: 1ch, (3dc, 1htr, 1tr, 1dtr, 3ch, 1dtr, 1tr, 1htr, 3dc) to end, join with a sl st to first st

Change to Plum Purple

Rnd 7: 1ch, 1dc in each st and 4dc in each 3ch corner ch sp to end, join with a sl st to first st, 64 sts

Change to Soft Blue

Rnd 8: 1ch, 1dc in each st and 2dc in each of centre pair of corner dc to end, join with a sl st to first st, 72 sts

Fasten off, sew in ends

stripy treble

Using 4mm hook and Apple Green make 17ch

Row 1: 1tr in fourth ch from hook, 1tr in each ch to end, turn, 15 sts

Change to Milky White

Row 2: 3ch (counts as 1tr), miss first st, 1tr in each st to end, turn

Change to Sailor Blue

Row 3: 3ch (counts as 1tr), miss first st, 1tr in each st to end working final tr in third of first 3ch at beg of prev row, turn

Work in foll one-row stripe sequence: Apple Green, Milky White, Fasten off, sew in ends

Sailor Blue, Apple Green, Milky White

Rows 4–8: rep Row 3

Fasten off, sew in ends

crochet clever

If you prefer, you can start Christine Harvey's granny square with a magic ring rather than a chain. See our illustration on page 62
